

## Universe is 13 billion years old and 92 billion light years in size

The universe has stretched by a factor of about **1,100 to 1,200 times** since its earliest observable light was emitted. The 92 billion light-year figure represents the *diameter* of the observable universe, while light has been traveling from the *radius* (about 46 billion light-years away) for 13.8 billion years.
